While driving along Ring Road during Dasain holiday (October) we noticed a lifeless dog by the side of the road.

When we got closer we realised it was still alive, though barely.

We put the dog in the back of the ambulance and drove to our consultant vet, Dr Balaram Thapa.

Nana, as we called the dog, suffered from a huge ear wound, skin problems, dehydration and malnutrition. He was probably abandoned after getting injured in a dog fight.

After emergency treatment we took Nana to the Chobar Animal Sanctuary.

Nana for weeks for weeks was too weak to walk. Sometimes he was too tired to lift up his head and just wagged his tail. He was clearly happy to be alive!

Nowadays Nana is a very active dog, who loves long walks, playing with other dogs and –last but definitely not least- lots of food.

Because Nana is an elderly dog he would soon deteriorate without ongoing support. That is why we decided not to release him back on the street. With the help of Animal Aid Abroad we look for someone to sponsor this miracle dog.

Nana together with Hazuur Baje are the first permanent resident at our sanctuary. We wish them a happy retirement!
