Debby reports on the rescue and ABC/AR program at the Chobar Animal Sanctuary.

Every week, Animal Nepal’s staff and volunteers catch, vaccinate and sterilise female dogs from the southern part of Kathmandu Valley.

In a moving image, Debby shows how during the surgery, Narayan Khanal takes some time to comfort one of the young dogs as it recovers from its anaesthesia.
