



CAMPAIGNING FOR CHANGE

At Animal Nepal we believe active welfare interventions, such as rescuing injured animals and lobbying and campaigning should go hand in hand.

Rescuing a blind working donkey is as important as drafting an animal welfare act. Without lobbying and campaigning, no long term solution can be found to problems such as the overpopulation of stray dogs, abuse of livestock and working animals, and the exploitation of wildlife.

Animal Nepal has been lobbying for an animal welfare act and the implementation of existing laws since 2004.

Our team organizes meetings with stakeholders, drafts petitions, letters to authorities and the media and gets concerned citizens together in demonstrations.

This month we campaigned against the widespread cutting of trees due to the government's road expansion project. We painted trees with slogans such as 'Save me' and 'Let me live'.

We lobby with local governments to stop the poisoning of dogs and instead introduce humane population management.

We are a leading partner in the Stop Animal Sacrifice campaign, which now gears up to stop the world's largest sacrifice festival in Gadhimai two years from now.

Animals do not have a voice that is heard by governments. We are their voice.
